

# DOCUMENT CHECKLIST CITIZENSHIP



# PLEASE PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING TO PREPARE YOUR **CITIZENSHIP** APPLICATION

## 1. Proof of Identity

- (a) Passport bio data page;
- (b) A full birth certificate from your country of birth OR a family / household registration document;
- (c) Evidence of links between previous and current names (e.g. marriage certificate, divorce certificate, name change document);
- (d) Three documents that cumulatively show your:
  - (i) Photograph (e.g. Australian drivers licence, or passport or UNHCR document or national ID card);
  - (ii) Signature (e.g. passport)
  - (iii) Current residential address (e.g. utility bill, lease)
  - (iv)Birth name, date of birth and gender (e.g. birth certificate).
- (e) An identity declaration completed by aperson of appropriate authority (usually a person working in a position from teh deisgnated list of occuptions). Hannan Tew will provide further instructions upon engagement.

#### 2. Character Documents

- (a) A police clearance from overseas countries if, since the grant of your permanent Australian visa:
  - (i) You lived or travelled overseas since he age of 18 years or over; and

- (ii) The total number of years psent overseas added up to 12 months or more; and
- (iii) The time psent in any one country was more than 90 days; or
- (iv) If you are requested to do so by the Department.

### 3. Children

- (a) Passport biodata page;
- (b) Evidence of any name change;
- (c) Any orders in relation to custody, guardianship or parental responsibility;
- (d) Evidence of adoption (if applicable).
- 4. Documents to show exemptions, Ministerial discretions and concessions (as applicable)
- (a) A letter or discharge papers from the Australian Defence
  Force or Austrlaian Reserve
  Force specifying service dates;
- (b) Evidence of a Departmental administrative error affecting yoru lawful or permanent resdience status
- (c) A statement to support the claim that you would suffer significant hardship or disadvantage if a variation to the residence requirement were not granted
- (d) A statement to support a claim that it would be unreasonable not to have a period in a prison

or psychiatric institution count towards the residence requirement;

- (e) Evidence of the Australian citizenship of your living or deceased spouse or partner and evidence of your relationship, such as a marriage certificate for spouse relationships, or joint utilities accounts, joint bank accounts, joint tenancy agreements, or joint mortgage agreements for de facto relationships and a statement explaining the reasons why you were both overseas and evidence of your close and continuing relationship with Australia
- (f) Evidence of eligibility for a fee concession. For example an eligible Centrelink Pension card, Health care card or Department of Veterans' Affairs card.
